Council Discussion Items

Approval of Meeting Minutes - February 18, 2022

Council Member Christian Roldan - Johnson motioned to approve the meeting minutes. Council Member Jose Muñoz Seconded the motion. All were in favor. The motion carried unanimously

Vice Chair Seat – Nominations and Vote

Council members sent their nominations to Mayra Magaña of CMS prior to the meeting. Council Member Christian Roldan - Johnson and Council Member Jose Muñoz were the nominees. Council Member Roldan - Johnson deferred to Council Member Muñoz. All were in favor, Council member Muñoz was elected to the seat of Vice Chair of the Council.

Updates on meeting with Directors of Agencies

Council Chair Roberto Sanabria indicated that a meeting with the director of DCFS has not been scheduled as of yet.

The council decided to invite the Director of IDCFS and HFS to the next meeting. CMS will follow up on the initial invite for the council. Council Chair Roberto Sanabria will send Mayra Magana of CMS a draft letter for a formal invite for CMS to send to the directors.

The council identified IDPH as the next agency they would like to schedule to meet with the director.

Council Bylaws

Council member Jose Muñoz indicated that the subcommittee has met and that he would be placing a draft in a shared file for the subcommittee. They will meet again and should have an update for the next meeting.

CMS Discussion Items

Mark Mahoney of CMS introduced Demoya Gordon, CMS Equal Employment Opportunity/Affirmative Action Officer. Demoya Gordon of CMS provided some insight into her background and experience and her enthusiasm for the work she will be doing at CMS and with the Council.

Assistant Director, Mark Mahoney of CMS informed the council that he was waiting for a response for the update on applications submitted by Giraldo Rosales, Javier Garibay. He

inquires as to whether Kenny Martin Ocasio had applied and Chair Sanabria confirmed that he had not yet applied but will be applying. Mark Mahoney of CMS will provide an update to the Council regarding the status of applications submitted by Giraldo Rosales, Javier Garibay, and Kenny Martin Ocasio.

Jose Lopez agreed to send a notice to the Coalition in East St. Louis to promote open Council seats.

CoreyAnne Gulkewicz of CMS provided an update on the State Workforce Diversity Numbers as of April 1, 2022, in comparison to the last two fiscal years. The overall state workforce has dropped in the last two years and has decreased slightly since February. The number of Hispanic/Latinx Code employees and Hispanic/Latinx PSA/SPSA employees has stayed the same since February. The number of Hispanic/Latinx employees in senior leadership went up by three since February.

The Council requested to start receiving data regarding the number of staff appointed, of which how many were Hispanic/Latinx and the number appointed positions that were vacated and of those who left how many were Hispanic Latinx. CMS will look into channels for gathering the data.

Patricia Santoyo-Marin of CMS shared with the council the Employment Plan Report goals and initiatives for the fiscal year as well as the Bilingual Report goals and initiatives for the fiscal year. Initiatives included new strategies for recruitment including a component reaching into the high schools as well as Spanish Language recruitment.

Chair Sanabria Inquired as to the possibility of Council members attending the Quarterly Latino Caucus meetings. Patricia Santoyo-Marin of CMS will look into this possibility.

Patricia Santoyo-Marin of CMS provided an update to the Council Meeting and Career Fair in the Community. The proposed date will be for the Q3 meeting on August 19, 2022, either in the Little Village location originally proposed or in the Humboldt Park region at La Casa Norte, pending availability for the Facility to host both the meeting and the Career Fair. The council will be updated as to the location once it is confirmed.

Patricia Santoyo-Marin of CMS indicated that CMS continues to engage with agencies who stated discrepancy between employment plan report numbers and their current employment numbers. CMS will next meet IDES Ex-Officio Designee, Anna D'Ascenzo who noted discrepancy for agency numbers.
