Under direct supervision, a chemist performs professional chemistry work in a state laboratory on such samples as animal feed, fertilizers, coal, food products, water, air, soil, animal blood and sera; interprets test results; retests if necessary; reports test results to immediate supervisor or lead worker for review and approval; releases test results after receiving the approval of the supervisor or lead worker.
