<u>Target Title</u>: **Corrections Medical Technician** <u>Position Title Code</u>: 09824 <u>Salary Grade</u>: RC-006 Credential or Certificate: Credential

There are few positions in the state, and they are located only at Department of Corrections facilities and primarily in the adult division. Technicians perform paraprofessional nursing duties in the care and treatment of physically ill and injured inmates at state correctional institutions. They supervise inmate workers in hospital maintenance and patient care. They assist doctors and nurses, maintain medical supplies, and perform inpatient services and preventative disease control. The Department of Corrections facilities operate seven days a week and all three shifts.

Minimum Training and Experience

Requires Illinois license as a Practical Nurse and requires one year of practical nursing experience.

Licenses or certificates, where required, must have been current within the past 5 years and must be submitted with the examination application.

Meeting the requirements listed on this annotated guide will entitle participants to be evaluated as QUALIFIED which is equal to a "B" grade.

Exceeding the minimum requirements by at least one year of full-time related experience, or related college, will generally entitle the participant to be evaluated with an "A" grade.
