This position is exclusively in the Department of Corrections. Positions are located in Fayette, Jersey, Kane, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, Logan, Montgomery, Morgan, Randolph, Rock Island, Saline, and Will counties.

A Corrections Nurse I, under general supervision and in conformance with established standards, procedures, policies and security guidelines, provides a full range of professional nursing services in the care and treatment of student or inmate patients in a correctional facility. Responsible for assigned nursing care activities in an ambulatory care setting including an outpatient clinic and/or an infirmary, utilizing professional training and expertise in the field of nursing.

Minimum Training and Experience

Requires possession of a valid Illinois license as a registered nurse and current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certification PLUS an Associate or Diploma Degree in Nursing or a Bachelor's degree in Nursing and one year of nursing experience* in an acute care setting, e.g., emergency room, medical/surgical nursing, and/or ambulatory care. A copy of the CPR certificate must be attached to the UMP promotional employment application.

* Licensed practical or registered nursing experience within the past five years.

Meeting the requirements listed on this annotated guide will entitle participants to be evaluated as QUALIFIED which is equal to a "B" grade.

Exceeding the minimum requirements by at least one year of full-time related experience, or related college, will generally entitle the participant to be evaluated with an "A" grade.

Corrections Nurse I is not an AFSCME represented title. It is represented by INA. Employees who promote into this title are no longer eligible to participate in Upward Mobility.
