Under direction, performs professional front line supervisory duties in a juvenile justice facility, overseeing security and the delivery of program services through subordinate staff within a Juvenile Justice facility. Conducts staff evaluations on an annual or quarterly basis, assigns, directs and reviews work of, and provides training and guidance to, subordinate staff.

Minimum Training and Experience

UMP will only pay for degree in Criminal Justice, Psychology, and Social Work.

Requires a bachelor's degree and two years of directly related professional staff experience involving the care of youth in a Juvenile Justice Facility, and providing for the safety, security, and well being of youth and staff as a Juvenile Justice Specialist or a Juvenile Justice Youth and Family Specialist.

Grading Guide

Bachelor's degree plus two years professional staff experience.

Meeting the requirements listed on this annotated guide will entitle participants to be evaluated as QUALIFIED which is equal to a "B" grade.

Exceeding the minimum requirements by at least one year of full-time related experience will generally entitle the participant to be evaluated with an "A" grade.
