Conducts staff evaluations on an annual or quarterly basis, assigns, directs and reviews work of, and provides training and guidance to, subordinate staff.

## Minimum Training and Experience

UMP will only pay for degree in Criminal Justice, Psychology, and Social Work.

Requires a bachelor's degree and two years of directly related professional staff experience involving the care of youth in a Juvenile Justice Facility, and providing for the safety, security, and well being of youth and staff as a Juvenile Justice Specialist or a Juvenile Justice Youth and Family Specialist.
