There are many positions, mostly in Mental Health facilities, with some in Veterans Affairs and some in the Department of Rehabilitation Services. A Registered Nurse I provides a full range of professional nursing services in the care and treatment of patients. Responsibilities include assigning nursing care activities in a patient, residential or health care unit, utilizing professional training and expertise in the field of nursing or serves as a general health nurse for a facility or an agency. These positions offer good opportunity for advancement to the level of Registered Nurse II.

Minimum Training and Experience

An Associates or Bachelors degree from an approved nursing education program, plus possession of a valid Illinois license as a registered nurse.

Meeting the requirements listed on this annotated guide will entitle participants to be evaluated as QUALIFIED which is equal to a "B" grade.

Exceeding the minimum requirements by at least one year of full-time related experience, or related college, will generally entitle the participant to be evaluated with an "A" grade.

Registered Nurse I is not an AFSCME represented title. It is represented by INA. Employees who promote into this title are no longer eligible to participate in Upward Mobility
