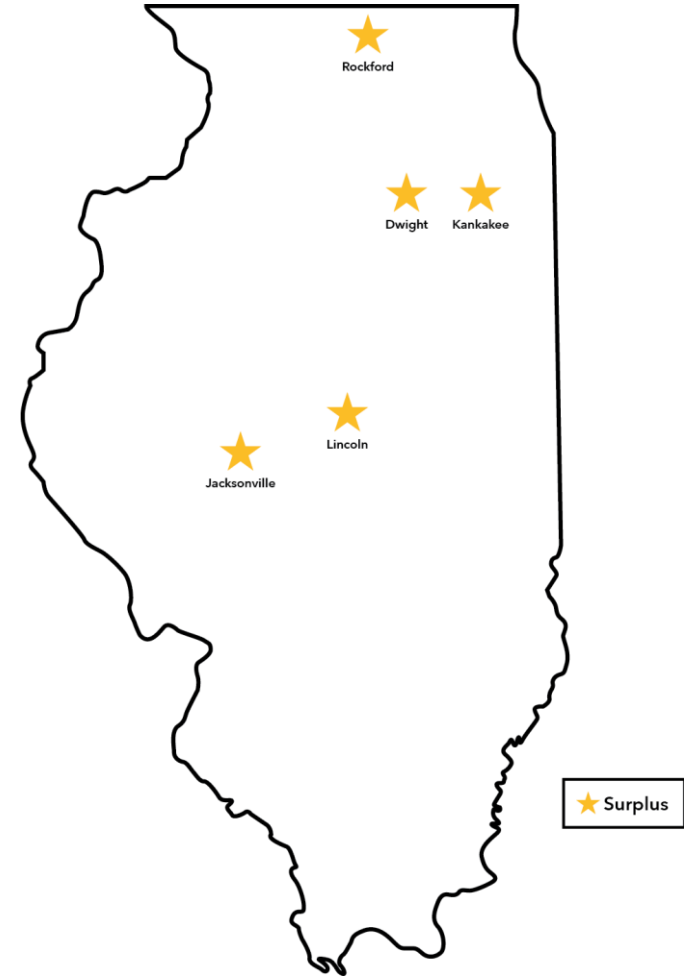
Surplus to Success (S2S) Overview

PURPOSE

On behalf of the State of Illinois, Governor Pritzker has authorized **\$300M** to prepare State-owned sites for private development within a new initiative deemed "Surplus to Success". The five sites are:

- **Dwight Correctional Center (DCC)**
- **Singer Mental Health Center (SMHC)**
- **Jacksonville Developmental Center (JDC)**
- **Lincoln Developmental Center (LDC)**
- **Shapiro Developmental Center (SDC)**

By repurposing these surplus properties, the Surplus to Success program seeks to drive economic development, enhance community well-being, and optimize the use of State resources.





Surplus to Success (S2S) Key Objectives



Site Remediation & Preparation

Cleaning up and repurposing State-owned sites that are no longer in use



Economic Revitalization

Stimulate economic growth, attract new businesses, and potentially generate billions in private investment



Community Enhancement

Revitalize local communities, increase property tax revenues, and reduce building maintenance costs for the State

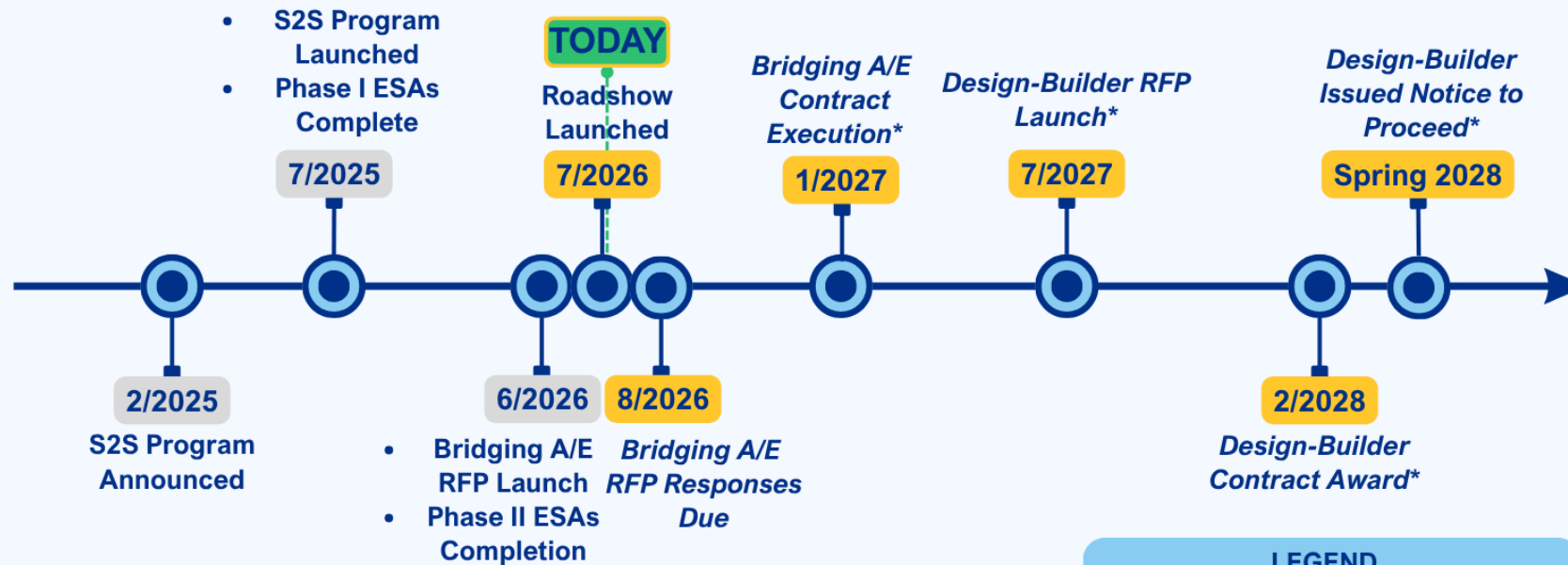
